Digital Skills are also embedded in our study programmes. Through personalised learning pathways and supported work experience with local and national employers, as well as Travel Training, Talkback supports young people to build independence and achieve their goals. Talkback students can also achieve qualifications in work-related areas, with every individual being supported as needed.

Our Mission

The Talkback Post-16 Specialist Provision, is here to support young people aged 16+ with a learning disability or autism to prepare for adulthood. All learning is personalised, so every student's learning pathway is individual and delivered by experienced staff. Talkback provides a pathway, a life journey from education, through to adulthood and into work.



Engage

A bespoke programme for young people aged 16-25 who are not in education, employment or training (NEET), or Post-16 re-engagement for young people who are home schooled and need support transitioning to the next phase of their lives. We help them re-engage with others in a safe and effective manner. Duration: 12–36 weeks.

Focus Areas

- Pathways into education and employment.
- Personalised pace for development.
- Safe, supportive environment for personal and educational growth.



Educate

For 16-25 year olds seeking a nurturing environment with smaller group sizes to build essential life and work/volunteering skills. Duration: 1 to 2 years.

Focus Areas

- Life Skills: Money management, social development, anxiety management, communication, and travel training.
- Qualifications: Functional Skills in English and Maths (Entry Level 1 to Level 2).
- Work Readiness: Building confidence for employment through a unique, rotating work experience programme with local and national employers.



Employ

A supported internship for 18-24 year olds with an EHCP, aimed at leading to paid employment. Duration: 1 year, 3 days a week.

Focus Areas

- To build on previous work experience and help achieve realistic career aspirations, that enable Talkback to find suitable employment opportunities.
- Workplace training and suitable qualifications relevant to future employment.
